



First Butte High Football Team

In 1893 a husky group of stu-Bretherton, formed Butte High School's first football team. Grid players of that era had to be husky heft. For those were the days of power plays, and it was not unusual to see the entire team form a flying wedge ahead of the ball carrier with players of the offensive team grabbing hold of their runn ners anywhere they could and pulld ing, pushing or yanking the ball toter along in any direction which would make the ball advance.

The wonder is, Harry Bretherton said once during a visit to Butte, (he now resides in New Mexico,) "that some of the ball carriers were not dismembered."

The Butte team played its first d high school game in 1894 against Helena, defeating the Capital City team, 8-4, and claimed the first Montana High School championship. Touchdowns in that era counted four points; therefore it is to be considered that Butte scored two touchdowns against Helena's one.

Bretherton coached and captained the team in '93 and was team captain in '94, when the eleven was coached by George Chase. Other coaches of Butte high grid clubs down through the years, have been:




Spartans Are Again Top Team of State




